## Project #1: Egypt

The school renovation project in Zowek has stalled slightly. As you are no doubt aware 2011 was a turbulent year in Egypt. The school project is currently at the 'planning' stage and these things take time, particularly given the current uncertainty within the Egyptian political system. The money is being held, securely, by Llew Edwards and it is our intention to complete the project, hopefully in 2012.

The 'Good Samaritan' fund was very successful, so much so that the CAP Committee were able to allocate a further £1000 over and above the original funds.
