Project #1: Egypt, Cairo Classroom + 'Good Samaritan'

Project co-ordinator: **Pr Llew Edwards**

In 2010 CAP funded the construction of a new schoolroom at a school for Sudanese refugee children in Cairo. In 2012 we repeated that project and built a second classroom, pictured here, at a **cost of £4000**.

This additional classroom eases congestion in classes and increases the number of students. This makes a difference to the income of the school and therefore salaries of the staff.

We also continued our support of Llew's 'Good Samaritan' fund with a **grant of £1000**. Llew uses this money for non-specific needs he encounters in his day-to-day work.

**CAP Contribution of
£4000 + £1000 = £5000**

Update: in 2011 CAP funded the renovation of a school in Zuwak in Upper Egypt. This project stalled following the political unrest of 2011/12 and remains



stalled. However the money is being held in safe keeping by Llew who tells us that a modified version of the rebuild project has been submitted to the authorities and hopefully will be underway in 2013/14. The CAP Committee recommend that we reallocate the funds already given to support this modified project.

Project #2: Bana Ba Rona, Maluti Adventist Hospital

Project co-ordinator: **Morgan Pulumo** runs the Bana Ba Rona "Our Children" project

This was a continuation of our long standing support for AIDS orphans in the area surrounding Maluti Adventist Hospital in Lesotho, southern Africa. Our previous contacts at the hospital, Wil and Lyn Hurlow (who visited our Church in 2011) have now retired from Maluti and the project is now in the hands of Morgan Pulumo. CAP asked him to present us with a 'shopping list' and we funded the following:

Project #3: ICC Feeding Program in the Philippines

Project coordinator: **Dave Caukhill (ICC)**

This was the second year of a 3 year program to fund the work of ICC in the Philippines and is a direct continuation of the 2011 project.

This project reaches out to the very impoverished tribal families in the Zambales Mountains, an area inhabited by native Philippine tribes.

Pictured is Edith Balacy, a 50 year old mother of three, who is the recipient of a 'microloan' from ICC that she has used to develop her rice farming and gasoline retailing businesses. Some of the money from CAP is used to provide these microloans which can make a huge difference to the lives of their recipients. These are loans, rather than 'gifts', and are thus paid back over time. Once paid back that money can then be recirculated into further microloans



for other members of the community.

Project #4: Perthshire Women's Aid (PWA)

Project coordinator: **Ruth Farrer**

PWA is a branch of Scottish Women's Aid (www.scottishwomensaid.org.uk) which provides practical assistance to victims of domestic abuse. PWA did not have a specific single project in mind for the CAP money. Rather our contribution would be spent on direct help, for example—clothing, food, basics needed for accommodation, translators for overseas clients and other necessities.
