Note from Karin Edwards. "Two years ago I was diagnosed with cancer, for which I had surgery and radiotherapy – and I thought I was cured. Six weeks later, follow-up scans showed that my cancer had spread to my lymph nodes and I was told there was nothing they could do to help me. I continued having 3-monthly scans, and six months later they told me that although my cancers were growing, they saw no further spread of the disease. Throwing me a 'lifeline' they offered me another course of radiotherapy with a strong enough dose to kill off the tumours. It was one of the hardest decisions of my life to decide to go ahead with the treatment, for there were no guarantees that it would be successful, and the side-effects were horrific. Last week I had the results of my latest scans to see if the treatment was successful, and I praise God as I share with you that my scans show me to be cancer-free! I know that Crieff church have kept praying for me, and I want to thank all of you from the bottom of my heart for your prayers and support. We have a gracious God who answers prayer, and I give Him all the glory! Karin."
